INFORMATION FOR AUTHORS

The Journal of Medical Investigation (J Med Invest) is published by Tokushima University Faculty of Medicine for the issue of original articles, case reports, review articles and others in the medicine. Four numbers that make a volume are published a year. Authors submitting a paper do so on the understanding that the work has not been published before, is not being considered for publication elsew here and has been read and approved by all authors.

Manuscripts should be carefully revised before submission. There will be charge of 11,000JPY per printed page. As a general rule, papers will be evaluated by two independent reviewers. Authors can indicate their recommended referees. Revised manuscripts should be accompanied by a point-by-point reply to the recommendations of reviewers and editor, specifying the changes made in the revised version. When the manuscript is accepted for publication, the authors must agree to automatic transfer to the copyright to The Journal of Medical Investigation.

The paper should be submitted in English. Manuscripts should be organized and numbered consecutively as follows: title page, abstract, introduction, patients and methods / materials and methods, results, discussion, acknowledgements, reference list, tables, legends to figures and figures in that order. Color illustrations are acceptable, however, the author(s) are requested to pay the extra costs. Author (s) should indicate the appropriate position of the text figures and tables on the manuscripts.

Abbreviations should conform to the style accepted in the Japanese Medical Sciences and used in the Quarterly Cumulative Index Medicus.

Manuscripts should be checked by a native English speaker. In some cases, an English certificate must be submitted.

All human investigation must be conducted according to the principles expressed in the Declaration of Helsinki.

All studies involving animals must state that guidelines for the use and care of laboratory animals of the authors' institution or any national law were followed.

Title page The title page should contain: 1. a concise informa tive title; 2. author(s)'s names; 3. name of department(s) / institution(s) to which the work is attributed; 4. name, address, telephone and fax numbers of the author to whom correspondence about the manuscript, and requests for offprints should be referred; 5. a running head of no more than 40 characters; 6. category (Original article, Case report, Review article, others); 7. conflict of interests-disclosure of any financial support and author involvement with organization (s) with financial interest in the subject matter of the paper, or any actual or potential conflict of interest-and if no conflict exist, a statement must be included for each author. Authors should also include the following details in the text: the name of the institutional or national ethics committee on human experimentation, the date of approval, and the approval number.

Abstract and key words The abstract must not exceed 200 words. It should state the purpose of the study, basic procedures (study subject / patients / animals and methods), main findings, and principal conclusions. Below the abstract, provide 3-5 key words that will assist indexers in cross-indexing your article. Use terms from the Medical Subject Headings list from Index Medicus, whenever possible.

Acknowledge persons and grant sources that have made substantive contributions to the study

Conflict of Interest Disclosure — According to The International Committee of Medical Journal Editors, "Authors should avoid entering into agreements with study sponsors, both for-profit and non-profit, that interfere with authors' access to all of the study's data or that interfere with their ability to analyze and interpret the data and to prepare and publish manuscripts independently when and where they choose." Authors must disclose any financial ties to organizations that funded the research or are associated with any mentioned product or procedure. The funding source and grant number must be specified. A Conflict of Interest statement should be included before the References section, listing each author separately.

Sample wording:

Conflicts of Interest: Author A received research grants from Company A. Author B received a speaker honorarium from Company X and owns stock in Company Y. Author C served as a consultant and expert witness for Company Z. Author D is the inventor of patent X. If no conflicts exist: Conflicts of Interest: The authors declare no conflicts of interest.

References Number references consecutively in the order in which they are first mentioned in the text. Identify references in text, tables and legends by Arabic numerals (in parentheses). All references cited, and only these, must be listed at the end of the paper. All authors' names should be described. Abbreviations of journals must conform to those used in Index Medicus of the National Library of Medicine. The format should conform to the examples listed below:
